CHART 1: Percentage of Respondents by Degree Program and Gender



CHART 2: Percentage of Respondents by Ethnic/Cultural Group







CHART 3-A: Percentage of Respondents by Age Range and Gender







CHART 4: Percentage of Respondents Earning or Having Earned an Additional Degree by Gender and Ministry Setting



CHART 5-A: Educational Debt Incurred at Seminary for All Respondents




CHART 5-B: Monthly Educational Debt Payments for All Respondents



CHART 6-A: Total Household Income before Taxes by Degree and Gender




CHART 6-B: Adequacy of Finances to Meet Current Needs






CHART 6-C: Monthly Educational Debt Payments by Total Household Income before Taxes

CHART 8: Percentage of Respondents Who Are Ordained or Licensed



CHART 9: Percentage of Respondents Attending Worship by Degree



CHART 10-A: First Professional Position upon Graduation - MDiv



CHART 10-B: First Professional Position upon Graduation - MA Professional



CHART 10-C: First Professional Position upon Graduation - All Others



CHART 11: Length of Time to Obtain First Paid Professional Position



CHART 12: Use and Helpfulness of Placement Services by Gender and Ministry Setting



CHART 14: Percentage of Respondents Working in a Congregation or Parish by Degree



CHART 15: Current Employment Setting of Respondents Not Serving in a Congregation or Parish



CHART 16-A: Current Position of Respondents Serving in a Congregation or Parish



CHART 17: Size and Location of Congregations Served by Sole Pastors



CHART 18-B: Current Employment Status of Respondents and Preference for Next Call



CHART 19: Level of Satisfaction with Ability to Use Skills and Talents in Current Position



CHART 20: Educational Setting in which Respondents Completed the Majority (more than 50 percent) of their Degree Programs



CHART 21-A: Effectiveness of Education in Four Areas of Study




CHART 21-B: Average Rating of Crucial Nature of Four Areas of Study for Work since Seminary



CHART 22: Three Most Lasting Influences of Education Other Than Course Work



CHART 23: Importance of Areas of Study in Professional Work



CHART 24: How Well Respondents' Theological Education Prepared Them for their Current Work



CHART 25-A: Respondents' Current Theological Views




CHART 25-B: Since Graduation, Respondents Have Become Theologically...



CHART 27: Percentage of Respondents Who Would Encourage a Young Person to Consider Ministry or Religious Vocation



CHART 28: Percentage of Respondents Who Would Choose to Attend the Same Seminary Again


