Advisory Committee named for Pathways for Tomorrow Initiative

The ATS Pathways for Tomorrow Coordination Program hosted the first meeting of its newly constituted advisory committee on March 15, 2023.

The *Pathways* Advisory Committee will (1) serve as an interpretive community reflecting on what is being learned through the initiative, (2) guide the work of the coordination program by providing input on the programming needs of the grantees, and (3) provide ongoing feedback on the effectiveness of the coordination program.

Members of the committee were nominated by Pathways for Tomorrow grantee schools and by staff from ATS and the In Trust Center for Theological Schools based on their roles as current or emerging leaders, their ability to think innovatively about the industry of theological education, and their expertise on one or more of the key themes emerging among the Pathways schools. The final slate of committee members represents the breadth of Pathways projects, the diversity of the grantee institutions, and the strong number of new leaders emerging as part of this initiative.

The first meeting of the advisory committee focused on re-orienting the committee to the *Pathways* Initiative and Coordination Programs and on building a learning committee among the members. Discussions focused on the needs and challenges facing aspiring and current pastors and lay leaders in congregations as well as on the strengths and challenges of graduate theological schools to meet these needs.

The *Pathways* Advisory Committee will meet again in May 2023.
