

Executive Director Search Committee retains Diversified Search, posts position description

The Executive Director Search Committee introduced the head of its consultant team, Dale Jones—president and CEO of Diversified Search—at the ATS Biennial Meeting June 28–30, 2016, in St. Louis. The committee of 12 members selected Diversified Search after interviewing six top firms with expertise in this area.



Diversified Search is a leader in diversity recruitment and executive search. Founded more than 40 years ago in Philadelphia, the firm has grown into one of the nine largest executive search and leadership advisory firms in the United States, conducting more

than 225 successful searches a year. It has grown by more than 30 percent in the last three years, and fully 75 percent of its annual revenue is repeat business from existing clients.

Diversified's recent successful searches have included the president of the American Bible Society, the president and VPIA of Columbia Theological Seminary, the dean of Duke University Divinity School, the president of



Interdenominational Theological Center, the president of Princeton Theological Seminary, and the president, CFO,

and vice president for seminary relations at Luther Seminary.

Jones will be assisted by Nalini Perkins and Charles "Chuck" Taylor, PhD.



Jones spoke to the Biennial Meeting attendees about the search process and aspirations for its outcome. Participants then shared their thoughts for the committee's consideration through table conversations. This input was solicited to supplement the membership surveys conducted earlier this spring.
